3.0401 House Numbering Required

All lots, buildings and structures in the City shall be numbered in accordance with the following plan:

South Avenue will be the North-South division line; running North and South, the east side will be even numbered and the West side odd numbered. The block between South Avenue and Oak Avenue will be the 100 Block South; between Oak Avenue and Ash Avenue, the 200 Block South; between Ash Avenue and Elm Avenue, the 300 Block South; between Elm Avenue and Pine Avenue, the 400 Block South. Finally, between North Avenue and Curlew Avenue, the 100 Block North.

Main Street will be the East-West division line; running East and West, the North side will be odd numbered and the South side even numbered. The Block between main Street and B Street will be the 100 Block East; between B Street and C Street, the 200 Block East; between C Street and D Street, the 300 Block East; between D Street and E Street, the 400 Block East; between E Street and F Street, the 500 Block East; between F Street and G Street, the 600 Block East; between G Street and the City Limits, the 700 Block East. Going West, between Main Street and Second Street will be the 100 Block West; between Second Street and Third Street, 200 Block West; between Third Street and Fourth Street, the 300 Block West; between Fourth Street and Fifth Street, 400 Block West; between Fifth Street and Sixth Street, the 500 Block West; and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street, the 600 Block West.

As to the actual numbering, each lot will have its own number; the first digit will be the block number and the last two (2) digits will be the lot number. Lots will be separated by at least two numbers. For example, lot one (1) might be 101, then lot two (2) will be 103.

As to those East and West locations that are on parts of lots, each block will be divided into four (4) lots for purposes of numbering. For example, on the North side of Ash Avenue, between Second Street and Third Street, the residences will be numbered 201 Ash Avenue West, 203 Ash Avenue West, 205 Ash Avenue West and 207 Ash Avenue West.

3.0402 Numbers of Houses

It shall be the duty of the owner and occupants of every house in the City to have placed thereon, in a place visible from the street, figures at least two and one-half (2 ½) inches high, showing the number of the house.

ARTICLE 3 House Numbering

3.0301 House Numbering Required All lots, buildings and structures in the City shall be numbered in accordance with the following plan:

1. All streets, except Main Street, shall run North and South and all lots, buildings and structures located on streets, except on Main Street, shall bear a number the first digit or first two digits, as the case may be, being the first number and the second number or numbers will be any number between one (1) and twenty-four (24) depending upon the location of the lot, building or structure. The first digit or digits will be the same as the avenue on the East end of the block of the street, for streets West of Main Street, and the same as the avenue on the West end of the block, for streets East of Main Street. All lots, buildings and structures on the left or South side of the street shall bear an odd number and all lots, buildings or structures on the right or North side of the street shall bear an even number of the twenty-four (24) numbers allotted each block, the most Easterly, West of Main Street, and most Westerly, East of Main Street, shall bear the smallest numbers. In so far as is possible each lot will have an even division of the twenty-four (24) numbers allotted said block.

2. All avenues shall run East and West and all lots, buildings and structures located on avenues shall bear a number the first digit or first two digits, as the case may be, and whether East or West of Main Street, being the first number and the second number or numbers will be any number between one (1) and twenty-four (24) depending upon the location of the lot, building or structure. The first digit or digits shall be the same as the street number on the North end of the block of the avenue. All lots, buildings or structures on the left or East side of the avenue shall bear an odd number and all lots, buildings and structures on the right or West side of the avenue shall bear an even number. Of the twenty-four (24) numbers allotted each block the most Northerly lot will have an even division of the twenty-four (24) numbers allotted said block.
